

Love in the midst of pandemic



February 14th is St Valentine's Day. Have you ever received a Valentine's card? Have you ever been surprised to receive a Valentine's card you did not expect? Have you ever received a Valentine's card and not known who it's from?

Saint Valentine is known today as the patron saint of lovers. There are different stories about the origin of Valentine's Day. Some people think that it originated from Saint Valentine, a Roman who was martyred for refusing to give up Christianity. He died on 14th February 269 AD. Legend also says that Saint Valentine left a farewell note for the jailer's daughter, who had become his friend, and signed it 'From Your Valentine'. Gradually, 14th February became the date for exchanging love messages and Saint Valentine became the patron saint of lovers.

What does 'love' mean to you? In the bible there are four words which can all be translated into English as 'love.' These four words all refer to a different type of love. 'Eros', or passionate love, is the love that we most often associate with Valentine's Day. It's the love that exists between lovers. 'Phileo', or affectionate love, is the love that exists between family members (- when they get on well!) or perhaps even between very close and trusted friends. 'Koinonia', or fellowship, is the kind of love that can develop between friends or people you get along with. Finally, there is 'agape', or the love of God. This is unconditional love. It is the highest form of love. It is perfect love that is often expressed in self-sacrifice of one sort or another. This kind of love sees the other person as infinitely precious.

God calls us to show this radical kind of love, one based on a conscious choice to be committed to support someone else for their benefit, regardless of their response to that gift. NHS and key workers are truly showing this kind of love as they care for all those who are struggling in these difficult days. There have been so many wonderful stories of one person helping another during the COVID crisis. My prayer is that our lives may reflect God's wonderful love as we seek, in appropriate ways, to help and support one another through these difficult days of global pandemic.

When are my items due back?

All items on loan, but not overdue, have been automatically extended to at least 31st March 2021. If your items were overdue before 25th December 2020, you will need to review these via your library account.

Return dates will be extended again if necessary, to ensure items borrowed are not due back until after Lockdown 3 is lifted.

You do not need to visit a library to return items at present.

Remember, all returned items are quarantined for at least 72 hours and remain on your account until the quarantine period is completed. Items are backdated to the date that you returned them.

To check your return dates, access your library account at www.librarieswest.org.uk or use the Libraries West app. If you need help logging in, or have any queries about your loans, library staff can assist by email librariesmail@somerset.gov.uk or phone 0300 123 2224

Trading Standards for Devon / Somerset / Torbay

Consumers urged to be aware

of fake texts offering Covid-19 Vaccine



Trading Standards is warning the public to be on their guard following reports that fraudsters are sending out fake texts offering a Covid -19 vaccine in an attempt to steal bank details.

The text offers a link to what police call an "extremely convincing" fake NHS website. Once on the website people are asked to input their bank details to register for a vaccine.

The scam message reads 'we have identified that you are eligible to apply for your vaccine' and then prompts you to click on a link for further information or to 'apply' for the vaccine.

If you receive a text or email that asks you to click on a link or for you to provide information, such as your name, credit card or bank details, **delete it immediately**. Remember, the NHS will never ask for your payment details.

Last year we did have a lot of damage over the grounds which has meant we have had to arrange for more CCTV coverage. We do notify the police and will take action if necessary.





JANUARY 2021

As I write this we are in the middle of heavy rain (floods in some places) and very low pressure which reminds me of last year's extremes: -

Jan. 20th, was the best January day SINCE 1957. It was the driest May for 100 years. June 25th was the hottest day ever in the world at 34°C and the 7th of August was the hottest day ever recorded in England, but not in Williton as it was only 28°C. September was the hottest month in the world ever Recorded. So, the MET said it is the driest summer as we had only 53% of the usual rain!

DECEMBER 2020

Frosts were seen on the mornings of the 29th and on the 25th it looked like snow on Christmas day.

The maximum temperature of 16°C on the 19th.

The minimum temperature of -1°C on the 31st.


The maximum pressure of 30.3 inches on the 26th.

The total rainfall was 147 mm.

Christmas really brought out the best in everyone following the challenging year – we had so many donations to our Gift of Small Things Christmas Appeal that we were able to deliver well over 150 bags absolutely STUFFED with presents for those most in need in West Somerset. A HUGE thank you to all those people who arranged drop off locations in their community and to the many people who donated - it made such a difference!

For Village Agents, the New Year and colder weather always brings challenges to our less fortunate clients who struggle with fuel poverty. Often the choice is between food and heating, which is a heart-breaking position to be in to have to make that choice.

We have many ways to help people in crisis or fuel poverty: – The **first** way is to donate you winter fuel allowance to the Somerset Community Foundation (SCF) here: https://www.somersetcf.org.uk/winter -SCF then work with us to allocate the donated fuel allowance to those in need. This year, many will need to stay at home to keep themselves safe and will find themselves cut off from family and friends and facing higher costs to heat their homes. Your donations will help us make sure around 500 vulnerable older people across Somerset have the support they need to get through the winter.

The West Somerset Crisis Fund has proved to be an enormously valuable and valued extra "tool in the bag" for Village Agents to help people facing personal and family crises. At this time of crisis and hardship for many in our communities this need is greater than ever, and we desperately need donations towards the fund.

- If you're not very mobile, are 65 or over, or have a health condition, such as heart or lung disease, heat your home to at least 18C.
- Keep your bedroom at 18C all night if you can and keep bedroom window closed
- Use a hot water bottle or electric blanket to keep warm in bed but do not use both at the same time.
- Have hot drinks often, and have at least one hot meal a day eating helps keep you warm.
- Draw curtains at dusk and keep doors closed to block out draughts get your heating system checked regularly by a qualified professional.





February's Recipe Lemon Sponge Souffle



This recipe was handwritten and copied from an older hand written copy from my mother in law. It comes down the line from Grannie Doxey whose family originated from Derbyshire and we believe it dates back to the mid C19th.

2ozs / 57gm Margarine 4 Eggs

10ozs / 283gm Sugar 2 Lemons

4 Tablespoons of Flour 2 Teacupsful of Milk

Cream together the 2 ozs / 57gm of margarine, 10 ozs / 283gm of sugar and 4 tablespoons of flour.

Stir in 4 beaten egg yolks, the rind and juice of 2 lemons and 2 teacupsful of milk. (one cup is 240 ml)

Finally fold in the stiffly beaten whites of the eggs and pour the mixture into a greased pudding basin and bake in a slow to moderate oven for 40 minutes. (300-350 f or 150-175c).

The pudding separates into two layers, a spongey cake on the top and a bottom layer of a creamy lemon sauce.
