#### Quantock Farmers ask 'Please do not feed the ponies'

Since the start of the Coronavirus pandemic there has been an increase in people feeding the ponies on the open hilltops of the Quantocks. These ponies thrive on the grasses, heathers and plants on the hilltops and do not need extra food.

Some horses have special dietary considerations and can be intolerant to foods such as carrots and apples and cannot have too much sugar. Giving them "sweets and treats" can result in stomach ulcers, which are very painful, and colic which can kill them. Many fruit and vegetables may seem like "healthy" or "normal" horse treats, but they are not suitable for many horses including the ponies which graze the Quantocks.

As many of these ponies roam wild over the open hills people are unable to know how many "treats" they have been fed and people are making the mistake of saying "just one won't hurt". A further issue of feeding the ponies is that they associate people and cars with food. They become more tolerant and will actively approach people and cars which increases the risk of people being bitten or kicked or the ponies being injured by vehicle collisions.

Ranger Andy Stevenson said, "Although they are beautiful to look at, the ponies are pretty wild and certainly not pets so keeping a little distance from them and appreciating them from afar is the best for everybody's wellbeing".

#### **BEATING THE BOUNDS - WILLITON**

I have found that these difficult times have given me a great opportunity to discover the hidden aspects of what is around us all. The daily walks (we are allowed) gives us time not only to walk but to contemplate the wonderful area which we live in.

I start my walks, opposite the Liddymore Estate (Cassino Road) which takes me from home straight into the Williton Parish. On this corner myself and members of the Parish Council have scattered wildflower seed. It is interesting to see what is coming up. Wild chive has raised its head, this is prevalent in some of the local fields/verges and the cutting that has been done has encouraged it. Also, some of the daffodils planted in the past have survived the cutting. We await the new seeds coming up.

If you head towards the coast from this point you might be lucky and see as we did the Shetland Ponies which amused me, I wondered if the wet weather had recently shrunk large horses! The day I walked this route was very wet and if you are going to follow it you need your wet weather gear, especially your boots.

When you reach the Doniford Junction, turn right and then right again past the Doniford Meadow bungalows and onward, the second gate takes you via the public footpath to Egrove. I took time at this point to observe the state of the river, not too high considering the wet weather we have had. The footpath to Egrove was very wet, I took time to congratulate myself on bringing my walking pole with me. It kept me upright.

When you get to Egrove you pass quite close to the houses, in the Spring/Summer there are a lot of flowers to look at by the houses. The path continues and there is a lot of pampas grass towards the river. You turn right at the end of the path, across the river. I always think that this would be a good place to use for producing hydro electric power, (looking for a grant here!).

The garden before the railway has a wonderful knot garden, full marks to the gardener. You cross the Railway, nicely spruced up with some new signs, and you are near the Industrial Estate. It's great that Williton has this facility. This provides work locally as well as producing useful things.

Carrying on down the main road, you pass Sir Gilbert Scott Court, another piece of Williton history – the workhouse, was here before it was converted into more genteel uses. I then made another right turn into Union Lane so that I could have a look at how the new housing is developing.

You carry on next to a dilapidated orchard. Wouldn't it be nice to see this replanted? Then at the end of the path you are back on the Doniford Road heading back towards Doniford. Just past Aller Mead Way the path runs out, it is the wish of the Parish Council to continue this path towards Doniford, but that is for another day.

You then go back towards the Liddymore Estate and you are opposite the site of yet another planned new estate. Oh dear, more housing.

This brings us to the start of another walk that I have done recently. If you walk to the coast turning left at the end of the road, you can access the beach through the coastal path. The very miracle of the surf can be seen, the waves that come in and out, twice a day, are something we can enjoy. I have stood on the beach quietly, revelling in the sound that goes with the surf, looking across the channel and up and down the coast, whilst contemplating if there is any way that the 'powers that be' can halt the erosion of the coastline.

What Lockdown has taught me is patience and appreciation of what we have.

April is almost here which is always a special time for me. We have had a terrible year with the lock downs and closure of all but essential shops. Let us look forward to May which could see easing of restrictions and really getting back to normal.

We have been very busy at the Parish Council throughout the Winter and Spring. Organising contractors and working on behalf of the parishioners. Amongst the things that have been done recently is the siting of grit bins at Half Acre Close, Bridge Close and Five Bells. This may appear to be a simple thing to do but it has taken many months of discussions with Somerset Highways not just to get permission to put them where they are but also to make sure that they are refilled each year to come so that road salt is in them when it is needed.

Another major project that we are working on is to help businesses in the village to recover from the effects of the Coronavirus pandemic. Last year we undertook a survey of the businesses to find out what their priorities were. The most common three responses were better free parking, more/better publicity and the reopening of the toilets in Killick Way. We have established a working group to find and deliver different ways to promote the businesses and reopen the toilets; and have applied for a grant from Emergency Town Centre Recovery Fund to achieve this. There is still a lot of legal work to be done before the work that is needed to be done before the toilets can start but it is hoped that they will be reopened before the main holiday season. Unfortunately, the Parish Council does not have any control over the car parks, but we are talking with Somerset West and Taunton Council and asking them to provide more and longer free parking bays.

May 6th is election day. This year the only election that residents will be able to vote on is for the Police and Crime Commissioner; elections were due for Somerset Council Councillors but because of the debates around the creation of Unitary Authorities in Somerset the Government has postponed that election until next year. For information about the two proposals for a Unitary Authority please have a look at the www.strongersomerset.co.uk and

www.onesomerset.org websites where there are links to consultation pages. Parish and District Council elections will next take place in 2023. Although there is only the one election it is still important that you vote as this will decide who will provide the oversight on how Avon and Somerset Police operate over the coming years.

All Parish Council Meetings have been taking place via zoom during the pandemic so we have still managed to get a lot of things done, and if you would like to join in on one details are displayed in the Parish Office window, alternatively please contact our Parish Clerk or visit our website. One date for your diary is 28th April which will be the Parish Assembly again details can be found on our website in the same way closer to that date.

We are getting more feedback from parishioners via email etc. regarding things in the village. We will always consider your comments and complaints and either forward to the appropriate authority or action it ourselves. Thank you.

#### Somerset's libraries reopen and launch 'Reading Friends' service

Our Temporary reduced opening hours are: Monday: 10am - 1pm Tuesday Closed. Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, Saturday: 10am -1pm.

Somerset Libraries are delighted to announce that as of the 8th March, almost all libraries have reopened, offering a limited service as lockdown measures start to ease. A new 'Reading Friends' befriending service has also been launched for those people who may feel lonely or isolated (see below for more details). Libraries are currently open in the mornings so that people can use the popular 'Library Choice' service whereby staff can pick a selection of titles based on what customers say they like to read, watch or listen to. In most libraries the People's Network computers can also be booked if people need to get online to help look for a job, access housing, or other government services.

Online, at https://LibrariesWest.org.uk reading fans can download a wide selection of e-Books, e-Audio titles, e-Newspapers, e-Magazines & e-Comics. These collections have proved to be particularly popular and the collections have been enhanced to help keep pace with all the new interest.

Browsing of shelves in libraries and the Mobile Library should be possible from the 12th April but in the meantime, we are very excited to announce the start of our new Reading Friends project, which provides the opportunity to socialise with others from the safety of your home. Reading Friends is a befriending project, which brings people together to talk about reading and share stories through phone calls, virtual groups and online forums. Our befriending phone calls will match participants up with a member of staff for weekly chats, whilst our virtual groups are informal online get-togethers where you can talk about books or simply just chat. This will also include a specific group for new parents and babies. Finally, we are also hosting an online forum for young people aged 14-24 on Discord. For more information or to take part email

The total monthly rainfall was 52 mm.



#### PHONE FRAUD WARNING INCIDENTS REPORTED IN SOMERSET



We're reminding people to be cautious and recognise signs of telephone and courier fraud following a number of reported incidents in Somerset in recent days.

We're investigating four reports in the Bridgwater area of fraudsters phoning potential victims and claiming to be police officers dealing with fraud.

In one instance, a woman in her 90s living in Sedgemoor, was called by a fraudster falsely claiming to be working for police in Bournemouth. He told her officers had arrested someone who had her account details and claimed her bank were involved in the scam.

He went on to encourage her to take out a four-figure sum from her bank and to lie to cashiers about why she was making such a large withdrawal, before handing it over to a 'courier' who would give her a password when he arrived. She duly handed the money to the fake 'courier' and also provided personal banking information over the phone, which led to money also being stolen from her account.

Fraud protect officer Amy Horrobin said: "Fraudsters tend to prey on the elderly and vulnerable people but anyone can be a victim. There's no shame in being tricked by these professional criminals, they can be very convincing.

"We must stress though police will never ask you to make a withdrawal from your bank for an investigation. They will never ask you to hand over personal banking details, such as your PIN. And they will never ask you to hand money to a courier who will collect it. The same goes for banks and other legitimate organisations and agencies.

"It is difficult during a phone call out of the blue to always think clearly, especially if the subject appears at face value to be very serious.

"So, if you are unsure if what you're being told may be a scam, then hang up the phone – the person at the other end of the phone will not be offended by you being cautious, if they are who they claim to be.

"Leave it five minutes, make sure you hear a dialling tone and the person who called initially has cleared the line, before then calling the organisation or company back. Use a number they advertise on their website or in the phone book. Don't use any number the person gives you.

"Alternatively call police on 101 or speak to someone you know for further advice."

We'd urge any other victims in the Bridgwater area to come forward and contact the police on **101**, giving reference number 5221045252.

Well, there is a dim green light some way at the end of the tunnel!! 

#### Cycle track / Path from Dovetons Drive/Union Lane to Roughmoor Industrial Estate via Slade Way Did you use it?

Over the years there have been a number of cut throughs made by the public from Union Lane into the Industrial Estate. Many cycled to work through these cut throughs including many dustbin men or were used by residents wishing to visit businesses as well as dog walkers and those going for a walk. Over the years a number of these have been blocked off.

The final cut though was blocked off by fencing at the end of January 2021 by the landowner, Exmoor Trim. This now means you have to take a longer route to the Industrial Estate by walking or cycling along Long Street (A39).

Exmoor Trim has been contacted and they do not wish to either reopen the link or relocate it.

#### Can you help?

To do this evidence has to be submitted by those that have used the link whether it is for a year, 5 years, 10 years or more. This means filling in a form which I then send off to Somerset County Council. I will need at least 20 people to fill in the form and at the moment at least 8 people have said they will.



## **Shuttle Bus Boost County Vaccination Programme**



A free Somerset County Council Taunton town centre shuttle service has been launched to get people straight to their vital vaccination slot.

The COVID-19 vaccination shuttle bus service started, Monday 1 March, following feedback, and will run every 30 minutes from Castle Way in Taunton town centre to Taunton Racecourse – one of Somerset's large vaccination centres.

The seven-day a week service uses one of the Council's fleet of minibuses and will help to support those who don't drive and will link easily with other operators coming into the town centre.

This follows other key transport support from the Council and partners including a regular shuttle to Bath and West Showground from Shepton Mallet, the suspension of concessionary bus pass rules for all public services before 9.30am and working with Community Transport and Slinky Demand Response services to allow free travel for bus pass holders attending vaccination appointments.

The new Taunton service starts at 8.20am each day, and will also serve bus stops along South Road and Shoreditch Road on route to the Racecourse. The last bus each day is 6.05pm from the Racecourse.

There will be capacity for a maximum of **four passengers** on each journey due to the need for social distancing.

The service is reserved for those who have a pre-booked vaccination appointment at the Racecourse and this will be verified before passengers board the bus.

It's recommended those using the service catch a bus to arrive approximately 10 minutes before their vaccination slot.

"I'm really pleased we're able to be able to work with the NHS in Somerset and offer this service now there's a need and get people to their appointments," said Cllr John Woodman, Somerset County Council's Cabinet Member for Highways and Transport.

"For those without their own transport this will be a free, quick, and stress-free way to get to the Racecourse from a handy location in the town centre.

"Please be aware if you want to use the service, spaces have to be limited for each trip so time your journey accordingly."

Alison Wootton, joint senior responsible officer for the Somerset Vaccination programme said: "We're really pleased that we can offer this new shuttle bus service and grateful to our colleagues at Somerset County Council for making this happen.

"It's really important that people attend their vaccination appointments when they are offered across our 20 different locations, and this is a great additional support to help people to come to their appointments at Taunton Racecourse.

The shuttle service is set to run every day throughout March and April except for the following dates when the vaccination centre is closed for race days:

#### 4, 15 and 23 March; 8 and 21 April.

Members of the public using the buses are reminded that face coverings are mandatory at all times.

The service will initially operate as a trial over a number of weeks, to gauge the number of people who want to take advantage of the service.




