

#### WHEELS is coming back!

WHEELS is a service in which car drivers volunteer to offer lifts at reasonable prices to members of the local community who are unable to drive or travel by bus. The cost of the lifts is further subsidised for those who have a Somerset bus pass.

WHEELS has unfortunately had to close down during the Covid pandemic, but as long as the Government does not place further restrictions on us, WHEELS is delighted to be able to offer lifts again from the beginning of August. For the first month, these will be restricted to lifts to and from medical appointments, but from September, we hope to restore our full service. All passengers should be fully vaccinated against Covid, wear a mask and sit in the back seat if possible. Drivers will also take suitable precautions, including vaccination, wearing masks, and cleansing car interiors between lifts.

WHEELS is always in need of voluntary help, from drivers willing to give lifts at times convenient to themselves, for which they receive a fuel allowance, or from coordinators who are willing for about one week in five, to take telephone requests and contact drivers to arrange lifts. 



#### **Faith Reflection**

We have certainly experienced a significant disconnect during the past year-and-a-bit, as churches closed to public worship and our ability to operate as community was severely curtailed. As I write, there is some possibility of this continuing beyond the June deadline in the famous "roadmap" but we all still cling on to hope that things will work out for the best.

Even if things do work out well, there will be significant changes to come in both Watchet and Williton given the retirement of both Vicar and Associate Vicar and the impending retirement of the Roman Catholic Priest in Minehead (who also covers Watchet, Williton and Dulverton). Add to this the fact that there is now only one stipendiary Methodist Minister in the local circuit and the way we work and worship will inevitably see some change.

Change is never really welcome, indeed it is said to be the "dirtiest" word in the English language, but it keeps on happening. Consequently, the best thing we can do is to face up to the fact that change is inevitable and to make the most of it. Prayer will help in this situation, and hope needs to go hand-in-hand with that prayer.

I know that the Anglican community is facing the long interregnum that comes with the departure of a Vicar, but I am certain that a replacement will be found. As for the Roman Catholics, we will have a replacement appointed before the incumbent priest leaves, and the Methodists have a great history of collaborative working which will see them through any troubles or difficulties.

Whatever the outcome of these changes, we can be sure that "God is working his purpose out" and with the addition of our prayers we can look forward to a future full of hope, going hand-in-hand with the "new normal".

May God bless us all in these trying but hopeful times.







Last year it was just short of £13.5 million. A third of that comes from the NHS but the other two thirds has to be raised in various ways. Fundraising made up a little under 14% last year which does not include the income generated by the charity's shops. The total months rainfall was 161mm, most of it 47+ mm on the 13th.


We had gales on the week end of the 3rd.

## **Down at the Station July 2021**

So, sadly we are still in semi lockdown which is not really good for the railway as also a lot of other attractions and locations, but we have to do whatever we can to get through this pandemic. I expect many have heard trains running during June and usually that has been twice a day on running days, as between trips the carriages are given a thorough clean through. The Company has also been experimenting with running some later trains allowing people to enjoy the evening sunsets over Blue Anchor. Like many other organisations the WSR is finding finance the biggest hurdle to overcome as the restrictions continue, as at very best they can only operate at 50% capacity and of course it costs virtually the same to fuel a steam train whether full or empty. The Company have recently launched another appeal for funds to help them through until next running season, and any contributions would be readily accepted at the Railway Station at Minehead.

During July it is hoped to run on more days each week and on many of them as far as Dunster where passengers may transfer to a bus to take them into Minehead, although they will have less than an hour there so I'm not sure how that will work in practice! As currently, all seats need to be pre-booked either by phone or on line. Times vary each day so it would be difficult for me to reproduce them here.

At Williton station all the flower tubs and beds have been planted out even if no passengers are able to get off the trains, they can be appreciated as they pass by. The hanging baskets are as delightful as ever. Meanwhile the station has been open for visitors to come down and enjoy the sight and smells of the trains and partake of a cup of tea or coffee etc. The Plant Stall on the station along with the Book Stall has been popular and I thank you for your support. The Plants Stall outside 7 Dovetons Drive will not be available there from the end of June. The funds raised through these stalls help towards the upkeep of the station, and like the Forth Bridge there is always something else that needs repairing or repainting. 



As Village Agents, we enjoy being able to respond to people's situation quickly and efficiently – we pride ourselves on being problem solving solution finders!

This can be from a seemingly simple task of finding someone a gardener to help reclaim an unruly garden that was causing a mental and physical distress, to being able to provide someone escaping domestic abuse the basics they need to start up a new home and keep them safe.

To do this we rely heavily on our Crisis Fund – an unrestricted pot of funds we manage that we can use to purchase things for people in need. People in crisis.

The Crisis Fund has proved to be an enormously valuable and valued extra "tool in the bag" for Village Agents to help people facing personal and family crises. 
