I wonder if you remember any of these and how they made you feel?

Do you remember the first person you kissed? Your first holiday? The first car you drove? Your first (mobile) phone? The first time you told someone 'I love you'?

I hope that after any of these events, one thing is true – these are moments when we find that our world has changed, forever.

It's a brave thing, to do something new, or to allow someone to become part of your life and allow them to bless you, just as you bless them. Yet, I hope you will agree: it's the greatest feeling ever.







Hedgehogs are one of Britain's most recognisable and well-loved wild animals. Did you know that the European hedgehog is one of around 16 different species found throughout the world?

They are most active at night and rest during the day in nests they have made of vegetation such as grasses, leaves, twigs and anything else they find which they think will be suitable. I cleaned out one of my hedgehog boxes



a couple of years ago to find a lovely, abandoned nest in which the occupant had at some time incorporated a sweet wrapper and a small piece of weed suppressant fabric!

They are naturally solitary animals, only coming together to mate. Although a few might be attracted to a plentiful food source. Most literature about hedgehogs will tell you that they don't share boxes, but we have had several different reports recently of two hogs sharing the same box! They reach sexual maturity at around 12 months old, but I am sure there are always the exceptions to the rule! Litters of three to seven will spend up to six weeks with their mother and then they set off on their own, to find food and build their own nests. The lifespan is typical at two to three years, depending on the habitat, food supply and dangers in their 'areas'. They have been known to live for seven years.

I don't know about you, but I have been finding lots of little 'presents' around our garden, in other words hedgehog poo! I am convinced that once you have seen, and recognised it, you will be looking out for it in your friends' and relatives' gardens. I know I do.



WILLITON WEATHER

On Monday 15th April, the BBC early news showed SNOW in Bradford! Here we had gale force cold (8° C) daytime winds. The gales caused a lot of damage, especially in the Midlands and Nottingham. However, on the 12th & 13th April, with the sunshine it reached 18° C - and in some places 22° C. And so the traffic was busy going to Dunster, Blue Anchor and Minehead, even at 3pm! The endless rain has caused problems for the farmers: crops flooded, fences down, etc.

Weather records for March 2024

The minimum temperature here (but no frost) was -0.5°C on the 28th.

The maximum temperature of 17 °C on the 18th.

The maximum pressure 30.35 inches on the 20th.


The minimum pressure 28.88 inches - 978 mm on the 27th.

The total rain was 172mm (From environmental data: wettest March in more than 40 years (provisional Met Office figures). Wales was drenched by 197.5mm of rain!

NATURE NOTES

The spring flowers, trees and other nature items are 2 to 3 weeks ahead of average. In my road, Rhododendrons (special variety, though) have flowered from end of March.

We won't see the total Moon eclipse here early on 16^{th} May, but we might see the phenomenon of the Moon reddening. Jupiter will be close to Venus and, about 25^{th} , Mars will be close to Jupiter.


