

I must admit that I love Christmas, all the razz-a-matazz of it all. The Christmas tree in my household has to be real tree as I love the smell of pine and am happy to put up with finding errant pine needles even in spring! As I get out the ornaments I am reminded of people and places; Mr Greedy for my eldest son, Mr Happy for my younger son, the handmade decorations made by grandchildren, the ornament we bought in Ludlow, the grandma bauble, the decorations knitted by my late mother-in-law etc etc. I love to watch the Christmas movies and sing the Christmas carols, but most of all I like to spend time in Advent, in the four weeks leading up to Christmas, in opening my Advent calendar, lighting my Advent candle and reading the Bible and other devotional books to remind me that Christmas is really all about Christ.







This is the first time I have written an article for the Williton Window. Watchet Hedgehogs group was started up 15 months ago, in conjunction with the Watchet Conservation Society. Since then it has become very apparent that there is a great fondness for our native wild hedgehogs in the area. Not just Watchet, but Williton also has what appears to be a good population of these iconic little creatures. Please have a look at our Facebook page and our website,

We are now coming up to the end of autumn and have had another influx of Hoglets as hedgehog mums have second litters. We are very lucky in that the word has gone around about what to look for, and how to help these little creatures. The need to act fast if you find a hedgehog which needs help is most important.

Autumn juvenile hedgehogs are ones that are old enough to be away from their mothers but too small to hibernate. The autumn juvenile season can start as early as September and is busy through until the end of November. However, some will struggle on and the occasional one can be found from December through until April. If the hedgehog is a regular visitor to your garden, is only seen at night, appears active and you are prepared to feed it every night then it can be left in the wild. However, if the hedgehog goes off its food, wobbles and staggers or starts coming out in the day or you notice it has green slimy poo especially if there is blood in it, and then it needs extra help as soon as possible. Even if you must bring a hedgehog in do keep putting food outside as there may be siblings or other autumn juveniles making the most of your hospitality!

If the food does not go you could continue to provide dry cat biscuits – these will not go off as quickly as tinned food so are less wasteful. Make sure there is water available, especially if feeding dry foods. It is helpful if you can weigh your visitor at least once a week if its size is a concern to ensure it is putting on weight and doing well. Any under 260gms in autumn are likely to be genuine orphans and should be rescued immediately. "Rescue" at weights above 600gms, based on weight alone, is strongly discouraged.

Make a feeding station for the outside hedgehogs. Use either a plastic child's toy box or storage box and cut a 13cm x 13cm (5" x 5") hole in one of the short sides. Place this over the food, like a tunnel, and the hedgehog can get through the hole to the food but it keeps cats out. A brick on top should stop the box being pushed aside. Another brick or large stone placed 13cm (5") from the entrance should stop a cat lying down and hooking the food out with its paw! Always make sure there is a little food left in the mornings – if not, you are not feeding them enough. (Information provided by The British Hedgehog Preservation society)

We are very lucky to have Hoglets Hedgehog Rescue at Sampford Brett, run by Louise and Simon Dunn. It is a small rescue and Louise and Simon care deeply for the hedgehogs in their care, looking after them until they can be released back into the wild. The rescue is self-funding and so any donations are greatly received. Members of Williton Social Club have recently collected £61 for the rescue and this will go towards much needed medications and food for the rescued hedgehogs.



Bethany's family closes her charity

West Somerset based charity Stand Against Speed 4 Bethany has closed after nearly ten years and shared its remaining funds among other good causes.

Bethany Paige Adams was killed in a car crash on January 7th, 2012. She was 17 and a front seat passenger in a car being driven by a young, newly qualified driver.

The charity was set up by Bethany's parents in her memory with the sole aim of educating young drivers aged between 16 and 25.

They delivered this in ways including a Choice & Consequence educational go-karting course, costing £30 per person, which was run alongside Dave Adams from Avon and Somerset Police.

Mark, Helen and Danielle Adams said in a statement: "After running the charity for nearly ten years we have made the difficult decision to now focus on our own well-being as a family. We would like to thank each person that has supported us over the past ten years – without their generosity we would not have been able to carry out all the hard work we have put in to delivering Bethany's story."

With what is left over, Stand Against Speed 4 Bethany has funded a defibrillator costing £2,300 to be installed on the outside of Williton Parish Council office in memory of Bethany. And a cheque has been presented to Dorset & Somerset Air Ambulance for £3.022.66: "Living in a rural location we felt that this money would be of great benefit to the charity," the family said.

The road safety props, and educational items have been gifted to Teddy Bears Nursery, which Bethany attended.





### SOMERSET BUS PARTNERSHIP

The future is suddenly starting to look a lot brighter for bus Services in Somerset.

Over the past decade, public transport has not been an economic and developmental priority for Somerset County Council. Residents of this large, mainly rural county have been encouraged to rely on cars to get them to work as well as to shops, hospitals and places of entertainment and bus travel has dwindled accordingly. Bus journeys in the County have fallen by 43% over the past decade, we now have the second lowest bus journeys per head in the country and our bus services have the lowest satisfaction score.

But the Government's Bus Back Better strategy has prompted a major rethink with £3 billion of funding for bus improvements to be shared out between transport authorities across England (outside of London). Somerset County Council has responded and developed a highly ambitious Bus Service Improvement Plan (BSIP) and is asking the Government to fund the Somerset BSIP with an eye watering £163 million grant. You can read the 184pp document that Somerset has submitted justifying this bid here:

www.somerset.gov.uk/roads-and-transport/transport-strategy (the BSIP document can be found under the National Bus Strategy Section).

Even if the full amount of the Somerset bid is not granted, it is a recognition by Somerset County Council that its bus services need major improvement. Transport is the biggest emitter of carbon in Somerset accounting for 44.1% of Somerset's total emissions. Given COP26, we must now make sure Somerset pursues the initiatives outlined in the Somerset Bus Service Improvement Plan that encourage a switch to public transport and away from single occupancy private cars. This will reduce our carbon footprint.

Somerset Bus Partnership was set up so that the voices of bus users from across Somerset are heard. We now have over 80 "bus representatives" from all parts of the county who ensure we understand and reflect the needs of towns and parishes across the county.

We are looking for extra support within the Somerset Bus Partnership's core team. Have you had management experience of the bus industry or in a transport department within a Council? Please do get in touch if you have.

Somerset is now entering an Enhanced Partnership with local bus service operators to implement the Somerset Bus Service Improvement Plan. Somerset Bus Partnership has been invited to attend the launch of the Bus Advisory Board in late November. This is Somerset's first step in establishing a partnership arrangement with local bus companies.

Somerset Bus Partnership will continue to work with bus users and will hold Somerset County Council to the ambitious and worthy goals now espoused in the Somerset Bus Improvement Plan.

A well attended meeting was held in Sampford Brett village Hall on Thursday 4th November. Jane Snell gave us an interesting and helpful exercise session, emphasising the importance of posture and the correct placement of feet upon the ground when walking.

This was followed by general WASP business concerning the problems of getting the blue stick accepted by Parkinson's UK. Two different ways of cleaning between your toes were shown for those members who could not reach their feet. One was a long and circular nylon soft bristled brush that could be used wet or dry available from the brush shop in Mere. The other an oblong shaped wire with washable cover on a long thick wire with handle, this was bought online.

We were then treated to an interesting flower arranging demonstration by the Carhampton Flower Group who showed us three very different arrangements. One for a table centre with a candle in the middle, the candle was ingeniously supported with cocktail sticks held round the bottom attached with tape or strong elastic bands and pressed into oasis. The second a large natural arrangement in a basket was demonstrated next and finally a modern collection of leaves and flowers that relied on colour and outline, phormium leaves were cut straight across and colour blocked for a very different effect. Raffle tickets were given out and three lucky members were given an arrangement to take home.

While we had tea and biscuits Jean Hodge went round those members who had signed up for the Christmas lunch to take their orders for the meal.

Next month there will not be the usual meeting. Instead, The Christmas lunch will take place at The Northfield Hotel in Minehead on Thursday 2nd December. The lunch is free for members, but friends may come too for a charge of £18.50.






