



#### CAN YOU HELP US TO KEEP GOING?

WHEELS, which offers a very personal, low-cost service to local people who cannot drive a car and find public transport difficult, is continuing to operate, mainly offering lifts for medical appointments.

A vital volunteer role in WHEELS is that of coordinator, who receives requests for lifts and then matches the passenger to a volunteer driver. Due to illness, we are very short of coordinators, and if we are to continue this service, we must find new volunteer coordinators

Coordinators operate from home for about one week per month, using the WHEELS mobile phone. They respond to requests from passengers and arrange the lifts, operating at times convenient to them. Full training is offered, and the coordinators offer a very valuable and much appreciated service to the community.

## **West Somerset Forum 21** Help with high energy costs:




We are giving surviving winter grants to people over 50 who find it hard to pay energy bills and we can advise everybody about grants, discounts, energy suppliers and home improvements. We are advised that there are no cheap deals on the energy market so switching supplier does not help, but a lot of people can get the £140 Warm Home Discount and vouchers might be available for people with prepayment meters. People on benefits or low incomes may get free home improvements such as insulation, heating improvements and renewable energy, and these grants are changing in April so it is worth finding out what is available now. We also provide low cost firewood.

The surviving winter grants are paid through a charitable organisation, Somerset community Foundation, which collects winter fuel payments from people who do not need this and we give it to people who apply for help. 

# Faith Reflection

January and February can be very bleak months. Christmas is over, the decorations are down, we've probably eaten too much, money might be tight and spring seems a long way off. Short days, long nights, cold and miserable weather; we can sometimes feel a real sense of hopelessness. There doesn't seem to be a lot of light. Where is God, we might ask? Does He care? The good news is that God does care, He cares about the big things and the small things in our lives. Sometimes we just have to look a little harder.

A few weeks ago, I took my daughter, Eliza, to London to try and get a visa for returning to France for six months, to continue her work with a Mission Project, working with Refugees in Caen. We spent two hours at the Embassy, to no avail, because of the current restrictions in France, they wouldn't issue her with a Visa. She was really disappointed. It seemed like a wasted trip to London, but as we reflected on it, we'd spent the previous afternoon in the Tate Modern having a lovely time exploring the different exhibitions, and when we stopped to have a late lunch, just at the right moment, somebody moved from their table and we were able to sit there, a table with the most amazing views over the River Thames, straight towards St Paul's Cathedral. It was wonderful and I could have sat there all afternoon. Anybody who knows me well, knows how much I love a good view! God cared about the small things, we didn't get the visa, but we got the best table in the Gallery!

Before Christmas, my son, Stuart, broke his phone, and he was feeling quite upset and angry about it, and found it difficult not to be able to communicate with us whilst we were in London. That next day, I cried out to God, asking him to reveal himself to Stuart, knowing that we didn't have the money to replace the phone and not really sure what to do about it. I prayed 'Lord, please, by the end of the day, let somebody, somewhere, provide Stuart with a phone.' That night whilst at his parkour club, I was telling one of the parents that Stuart had broken his phone and was deeply upset about it. To cut a long story short, within half an hour she had provided a phone for him, an old one she had sitting in a drawer at home. Stuart was speechless when he came out of the club. I said to him, 'that God, that you're currently very grumpy with, well guess what? This morning I asked him to somehow get you a phone and look what's happened?!'

God knew how important this was to Stuart, a small thing, but God cares about the small things, and if we look hard enough, we can find God in all sorts of places. As Desmond Tutu said, 'Hope is being able to see that there is light despite all of the darkness.' Sometimes things seem bleak, but if we look hard enough, God is there, because he cares about the small things.

#### **February Parish Council News**

Despite Covid restrictions and all the delays that this can be blamed for, one thing has come forward quite quickly. A grant was successfully applied for in the autumn to run an activity to help people who have been self-isolating from the virus to begin safely meeting up with friends.

The Parish Council contacted the Foxes Academy in Minehead and asked if they could prepare and serve lunches once a week in the Pavilion on the Memorial Ground. They agreed, so a joint project is now up and running. The first lunch was served on Tuesday 11th January and was enjoyed by everyone who attended. The students from Foxes who prepared and cooked the food, found the experience worthwhile. As a result lunches will now be served every Tuesday. There is a £3 charge to cover the cost of the food. Doors open at 11.45am and food is served at 12.15pm. Places are limited. Different organisations which help us in the community are there, both professional and voluntary, and can give advice on many issues which may be troubling you. The Café follows on straight after the Community Lunch, so why not round it off with a chat to other people, make some new acquaintances and enjoy the light refreshments in a very friendly atmosphere. The Café is one of the longest running events since the Pavilion opened and has helped many people get around all manner of issues making lives more pleasant and less stressful. At this time of year it is normally quiet on the hedgehog front as the majority of our spiky friends should be hibernating. However, our climate is changing and this winter it has been very mild, meaning that a few of you have been seeing hedgehogs out in your gardens until after Christmas! I have had reports from Williton residents to say that they are still feeding hedgehogs which come regularly to their feeding stations.

I was very pleased, yet again, to receive a donation for Hoglets Hedgehog Rescue at Sampford Brett, from members of Williton Social Club. So I thought you might like to know what happens when a hedgehog is taken into a rescue centre for help.

The hedgehog is firstly weighed and a note made on a record sheet. This is to monitor whether the animal is putting on, or losing, weight. An assessment is made to see if there is an injury, fly strike, maggots, internal parasites, dehydration etc., so that the correct treatment can be given straight away. If it is cold it will be put onto a special heat pad to warm up. It is imperative that treatment is given from day one so that the hedgehog will have a good chance of surviving and being released back into the wild, which is the aim of every wildlife rescue. It is put in a box in a quiet place, with warmth, food and water and something to hide under and will be monitored daily to ensure it is putting on weight and that any wounds are healing (serious wounds will be dealt with by a vet).

Don't be tempted to 'hang on' to a hedgehog you have found which looks as though it needs help. Contact a rescue for advice. Hedgehogs are very good at 'masking' problems and one which has been rescued may suddenly appear lively and desperate to get out of its box. This may be a symptom of a heavy internal parasite burden and so the sooner it goes to a rescue the better its chance of survival.

It is certainly not cheap to run a rescue. Food, bedding, heat pads, medication, accommodation (i.e. storage boxes or small animal cages), washing bedding etc. are expensive and if it were not for the generosity of local people then rescues would not be able to exist. In the case of hedgehogs, this would be a disaster as they are vulnerable to extinction and we must do all we can to ensure their survival.





The total rainfall was 85 mm (most of this in the last week).


#### SUMMARY


Geoff always felt a strong connection with Watchet always reminding anyone who would listen that Yankee Jack was his great, great uncle.
