



Dear Friends

Thank you all so much for your amazing response to our Easter appeal and we have distributed seventy parcels filled with Easter treats, through the Community Network, Home-Start, Schools, Foodbank and Pantry. Having spent the last two Easters in lockdown, it has been wonderful to be out enjoying the spring sunshine without constraint and the joyous freedom of meeting with family and friends.

In February's newsletter we highlighted the inequality of access to the Foodbank and Pantry Pilot and our desire to find an area wide solution, and on Tuesday 22nd March a stakeholders meeting took place which was both positive and constructive. A new E-Mobile Pantry project has been initiated, to facilitate access for rurally isolated communities and a project team formed. The lead time for delivery of such a vehicle is around 12 months as manufacturers of some parts are located in Ukraine. The Foodbank's new project would deliver zero carbon, in line with the County Council's action on climate change which has been rated best in the UK; as has Somerset West & Taunton District Council, where projects in our own area have delivered electric vehicles for community transport. In the interim, the project team will be looking at other temporary arrangements.

Meanwhile, our volunteers and trustees continue to work extremely hard to meet the needs of our local communities, and representatives of the Foodbank were presented with the Millington Shield by Watchet Town Council on Tuesday 12 April. The shield is given each year to a local community organisation "to highlight the most valuable contribution they have made to the town".

Part of the citation reads:

'Working in Partnership with local agencies who provide referrals, the Quantock Foodbank has been providing a vital service to those in need of help from its base in Watchet across its coverage area including the rural Quantock villages'. 'Peak demand quadrupled during COVID lockdowns, but was met by the amazing generosity of donors and the efforts of volunteers and trustees operating the Foodbank.'

We were very pleased that Watchet Town Council decided to recognise what we do in this way and we thank them for their continued endorsement of this necessary work.

Your loyal support means a lot to us and we enjoy seeing some of you each week and having a chat.

Faith Reflection



How You Can Help



You should now be seeing hedgehogs out and about again after the winter 'hibernation period'. Although, this winter a lot of hedgehogs did not hibernate because it was so warm, or if they did it was only for short periods.

I would like to tell you all about recording sightings of hedgehogs, alive or dead, and the reason for doing so. In the 1950's the population of our native hedgehog in the British Isles was estimated at around 30 million. However, now the population is estimated to be under 1 million. It is really important that organisations such as the Peoples' Trust for Endangered Species, the Hedgehog Preservation Society and local wildlife recording centres, are told about sightings as it gives them some sort of idea of the health of our hedgehog population. Whilst hedgehogs are currently classed as 'vulnerable to extinction', urban populations seem to be increasing slightly. This is probably due to our awareness of this little wild creature and what it needs to survive.

If you are able to, please record sightings on the Hedgehog Street website. www.hedgehogstreet.org when you go onto the website you will see a section called 'Home of the BIG Hedgehog map. Click on MAP and this will take you to the page where you can report sightings. Click on 'I've seen a hedgehog' and complete the form, and don't forget to submit it. Once you have done this your sighting will be recorded on the Big Hedgehog Map. You can also access this website via our own website, www.watchethedgehogs.org If you have any questions about this please let me know.

I am pleased that so many of you love our native Hedgehogs and are doing all you can to make it welcome in your gardens. Let's make Williton a 'Hedgehog E-mail: Janeyb8@hotmail.co.uk, Phone: 07918 603059 Friendly Village'.

God Gave Me A Miracle

Here is my story. On Monday evening March 31st I had a bad headache on the right side of my head. I sometimes get a sinus headache which I thought it was. However, partly through the night

the pain got worse, and I was unable to sleep in spite of taking pain killers. Praise God, a house across the way from us had left an outside light on, showing a pattern of stripes on our bedroom ceiling. (Thanks God) as I looked, I realised that I could see the stripes through my left eye, but through the right it was a blur. I got up and found that all usable sight had gone from my right eye. For fear it was a stroke, I phoned the ambulance and was taken to A&E. After lots of questions the doctor looked at my eye and said "it just isn't working" I asked him what he meant and was told that the functions of the eye didn't do anything. He asked if it had been bleeding and then told me "it is serious" I was sent for a CT scan and then sent as an emergency to the eye clinic.

By then my pain level was 8 out of 10. It seems that the pressure in my eye was at a level to have damaged the eye and treatment had to start immediately. Several different kinds of eye drops were given at about ten minute intervals. Slowly the pressure started to reduce as did the pain. This went on for some time and then I had to have a big injection into my arm which had to be given slowly over three or four minutes. I was warned that I would get pins and needles over my body, but that didn't happen.

Next, I was given laser surgery to both eyes. To the right to help a cure and to the left to prevent anything happening in the future. The consultant was amazed that there had been no damage to my eye and thanks to me getting to hospital quickly I was able to receive emergency treatment. My eyesight is now amazing, and I have to take tablets and lots of different eye drops through the rest of this week. On the Friday, I had to return for more laser surgery. Reading on the NHS site it informed me that the problem could be stopped but damage to the eye was permanent.

Finally, our son Andrew who works in Taunton, finishes work at 4.40 pm and I was discharged at 4.00 pm so I had a lift home. The consultant was amazed that my eye was not damaged, he shared with his assistant that even the back of the eye was fine.



I thank God for a miracle in treatment and in the details of my day. All due to those many, lovely friends who have prayed. I was once in darkness, now my eye can see, I was lost but Jesus came to save me. Hallelujah!





These two trusts exist to help local people who are in hardship, need or distress. Between them they can help people who live within a six-mile radius of the ecclesiastical parish of Watchet as it was delineated in 1935. This is a relatively wide catchment area.

One of these charities can trace its origins back to the reign of Elizabeth I, when wealthy locals established a fund to help soldiers returning from the wars in Ireland and their families, together with the families of those who did not return, and to look after, what was at the time the sole Parish Church for both Williton and Watchet, that of St. Decuman on the hill just outside of Watchet. Over the years this charity has helped local people with many things: essentials, accommodation, fuel, blankets, food etc. The charity has adapted and been added to over the centuries. Today as a trust it operates by making small grants to individuals and organisations that support individuals and also helps with grants for the repair and maintenance of St. Decuman's Church.

The other charity is the result of the generosity and care of Mary Huxtable Sutton who left funds to help local people, principally the elderly and those who were working and in need. Today as a trust it also makes small grants to individuals and organisations that support individuals.

If you, or someone you know, think that these Trusts might be able to help with a small grant for a specific purpose, particularly as we come out of these two difficult years of the covid pandemic and with the drastic increase in fuel prices for heating our homes that we all face, please speak with our local Village agents Izzy Silvester and Ruth Wake, contacts at local churches, or if you are a Magna tenant, the local Magna Tenant Advisor, who are all able to refer requests on to the Trusts. 

NATURE NOTES



ASTRONOMICAL NEWS

Throughout April, four bright planets will be seen in the southeast just before sunrise, before dawn, yellow dot of Saturn positioned just to its right (West). Mars will be just more to the right a bit later, with Venus visible longer: then a brighter Jupiter will rise to Venus' lower left. But I cannot see

There is an enormous comet -- approximately 80 miles across, at 22,000 miles per hour from the edge of the solar system, it will never get very close so poses no danger to us.

If you wonder what use is the space station; well amongst many other things they are testing a method of producing semiconductor crystals, studying solidification of transparent alloys (for use in industry), and most useful to us clothes to provide radiation protection. PJ.



The Step Up to Mobile Outreach programme is being funded through Somerset County Council's successful bid for Community Renewal Funding from the Government.






