ROM OUR VILLAGE AGENT, IZZY SILVESTER What is A Village Agent



The Village Agent service is part of the Community Council for Somerset (CCS). It offers free, confidential, practical support to anyone in need, including community groups.

CCS Village Agents are local, problem-solving solution finders. There are over 60 Village Agents all over Somerset.

Sounds interesting but WHO can they help?

A Village Agent can help if....

- You are an unpaid Carer or looking after someone else informally & need a little help & support for you and the person you care for.
- You are struggling with a problem, big or small, but don't know where to turn.
- You are feeling lonely and isolated.
- You are part of a community with a collective problem & need a kick start to solve.

It doesn't matter how big or small the problem is, CCS Village Agents are here to help.

If you receive help from Adult Social Care, you may be referred to a CCS Community Agent, who works directly with referrals from the ASC team. They are very similar to a Village Agent but may have different experiences and knowledge in specific areas, such as mental health or learning difficulties. All CCS Agents work closely with local GP surgeries and the Adult Social Care team, so a person has well-rounded, co-ordinated support.

OK that's great – but HOW exactly can a Village Agent help?

It's probably easier to list the things Agents CAN'T do!

It's very difficult to pin down exactly how a Village Agent can help, as each person's situation is unique. In short, they can help make life better with the right connections, and practical community-based solutions. Here are a few recent examples of how they have helped people:

- Supported clients to access transport so that they can attend medical appointments.
- Arranged with the local food bank to supply food to individuals, families, couples.
- Source & arrange delivery of white goods, furniture & household items to people in need.
- Made sure that the clients are supported to get the financial help they need.

- Arranged translations for clients who don't speak fluent English but need our support.
- Supported people who need help collecting prescriptions.
- Conducted welfare calls on behalf of local GP's to ensure clients are safe and well.
- Gave emotional support to people who are feeling isolated and lonely.
- Supported people (particularly unpaid Carers) with brokering a Micro-Provider. This is specialist paid-for support from personal care to cleaning whatever your need is, a Micro-Provider can help with daily living tasks.
- Support elderly Somerset residents to 'survive winter' by making sure that they have sufficient heating and cooking facilities, and distribute Surviving Winter grants.
- Gifted refurbished mobiles to people who are cut off from their family & friends.
- Helped people to get home from hospital or temporary accommodation.
- Found & made connections between clients & the right community-based support.

Hello To All Car Drivers!

If you have a car and even a little time you can spare, WHEELS, the local voluntary car scheme, would love to hear from you.

There are local residents, mainly elderly people, in Watchet and Williton, who are unable either to drive themselves or to catch buses, which makes it very difficult for them to keep medical or dental appointments, visit their partners or friends in care homes, do their shopping, or even just get out of the house and meet other people.

WHEELS is a group of drivers who offer personal, door to door lifts in their own cars for as low a charge as possible, to avoid the practical difficulties and sometimes the isolation of those who cannot get about under their own steam. As well as being able to claim a mileage

allowance, these drivers meet some lovely passengers, and know that they are providing a service which is very much appreciated. Drivers choose the journeys they wish to undertake, which may be as frequent or occasional as they

Summertime sniffles, bites and rashes? Think Pharmacy

Pharmacy a new service launches for quicker treatment of minor conditions in Somerset

A new GP community pharmacy consultation service (CPCS) is being rolled out across Somerset to help patients with a range of minor conditions, such as skin rashes, aches and pains, access quicker treatment via their local community pharmacist.

Patients using the service for minor conditions, are already freeing up approximately 1000 GP appointments every month in Somerset for patients with more complex conditions.

Now, when you contact your GP regarding a minor condition, after discussing your condition, where appropriate, the receptionist will offer you a same day appointment with a community pharmacist of your choice – in person, or over the phone

Community pharmacists have already successfully seen thousands of patients in Somerset for a consultation for a minor condition since the scheme was piloted in Somerset GP practices.

The service is proving particularly popular with parents of toddlers and teens and older people for conditions such as eye and ear infections, sore throats, skin infections, sprains and urinary tract infections and for those with common summer conditions such as hay fever, insect bites and skin rashes and those with sprains and falls.

Minor illnesses or injuries could include:

- Ankle, foot, knee, leg or arm strains and aches
- Bites or stings
- Coughs and colds
- Eye and ear infections
- Hay fever
- Headaches
- Mouth ulcers and blisters
- Rashes
- Skin conditions
- Sore throat
- Urinary Tract Infections (UTI's)

How the service works



You will be contacted by your nominated community pharmacist to arrange any appointment for a consultation in person or on the phone. When you have a consultation for a minor condition, your pharmacist will take your medical history, ask about your symptoms and any current medication you might be taking. Following the consultation, they will offer you clinical advice and if appropriate, offer you an over-the-counter product. Increasingly pharmacies can also prescribe medication such an anti-biotics and are often open at evenings and weekends. The pharmacist will make a record of the outcome of your consultation and send it to your GP.

If having given you advice or treatment, your pharmacist thinks you may need further specialist help they will be able to refer you back to your GP or recommend another health service for support.

Dr Jeremy Imms, Associate Clinical Director, Somerset Clinical Commissioning Group, said: "The Somerset Community Pharmacy Consultation Service will be of huge benefit to many of our patients as lots of minor conditions are more appropriate for a consultation with a community pharmacist, rather than a GP.

"This will improve access for patients with minor illnesses and will also help us to free up GP appointments for people with more complex health needs; helping ensure everyone gets treated at the right time, by the right healthcare professional.

"At this time of year people are beginning to experience seasonal conditions, such as hay fever, insect bites and rashes, and more sporting and other minor injuries from just being outdoors more. Our community pharmacists are highly experienced in diagnosing and treating common complaints, and patients will now have the ability to choose to have their consultation with a pharmacy close to home at a convenient time."

Michael Lennox, CEO of Community Pharmacy Somerset, said: "Community Pharmacists are highly trained healthcare professionals with five years training and spend a high percentage of their time helping treat patients with minor illness and recommend over-the-counter treatments where necessary.

"Pharmacies across the area are often open during evenings and throughout the weekend and can provide support on the same day via the phone, with most having rooms available for a private consultation.

"As well as saving you time, getting support from your community pharmacist frees up appointments for your GP to see more urgent patients. If we think you do need to see a GP, we'll always advise you to do so.



On Thursday 14th July we are holding a meeting at 7pm in Williton Pavilion to discuss the help that farmers can provide for wildlife, and how we can help people get

affordable, healthy food. Everyone is welcome we would like to hear your views. It is being organised by the West Somerset Together network and Williton Parish Council with contributions from farmers organisations, community growing projects and local food outlets. Nature friendly farming helps wildlife and locks in carbon, so it tackles both climate and biodiversity crises. It involves restoring the landscape with measures such as planting hedges, trees, and wildflower meadows, enriching the soil to retain water and preserving wetlands.

We can support these initiatives by buying food that has been grown or reared sustainably and knowing how our food was produced; or we can grow our own. There are now many outlets for local food, on the farms, at farm shops, traditional butchers and farmers markets, and on-line. We are considering setting up more. There are schemes to make it affordable like community supported agriculture which is a partnership between farmers and consumers where work is partly done by volunteers who get cheaper food. And new projects are helping people access land for growing food.



The total rainfall was only 25mm. (Very Very Low)


NATURE NOTES

Mars will fade from view around July 18th until October. We may see meteor showers from July17th for about 2 weeks. PJ.




