Faith Reflection Where is your Gethsemane?



I was recently on a training day with the Diocese and was asked the question: "where is your Gethsemane?"

Where do you go like Jesus to recharge and to spend time with God? We all need a place to reflect on the ups and down of everyday life and realign because if we don't, we run the risk of becoming emotionally and spiritually exhausted. Some of the most "Godly" people I know take time out to replenish and refresh, it's how they keep doing the things they do, without it they would run the risk of serious burn out. The problem seems to come when the idea that sitting, of being still and resting, is just a time wasting exercise that should just be filled with other stuff. It should never be seen as wasted time, but necessary time, for our own wellbeing and for our own relationship building with God. And even if you struggle with the Christian way, you still need to take time to rest from the day to day workload and struggles, whatever that might look like for you.

After getting a few minutes to think on the question of Gethsemane, it was amazing to hear the different places and practices that individuals have and do, to find that God space. From running to yoga, painting to poetry and prayer and meditation of course, the most common idea of Gethsemane seemed to come with being outside. I wasn't surprised to be honest, because who doesn't feel surrounded by the greatest "Artist" in His most beautiful and complex creation and we are very blessed here in this area. You don't have to go far to see His most beautiful painted canvas of the Quantocks and the coastline.

For me though I am blessed with the most beautiful of gardens with an amazing view of a hillside. On that hillside I can sit and loose myself in all that troubles me, and I know every hedgerow and tree. Even when it became a muddy mess, I still dwelled in it. It is on that hillside that I refresh myself, realign myself and most importantly talk with God; not forgetting to listen of course.

When you come to the meeting a warm and friendly lady is there to greet you. She will ask you what you want to drink so our tea ladies can have it ready for the chat session. You will see people smiling and greeting each other, just like friends do everywhere.

Next you are offered the opportunity to join in for the exercises. Nothing too strenuous but movements to help you cope with daily life. You feel much more relaxed and ready to get on with the meeting, we have such a diverse list of speakers, but it is good to hear about something different on all subjects.

Everyone is ready for their tea or coffee, with a biscuit of course. We all have name badges and try to remember to wear them. This helps to talk to others in the group. If you look around you will see a group of friends all mixing in to have a good time. You may want to talk to others and get some ideas on how to cope with all the various problems that Parkinson's brings. People are not shy to speak up because they know that everyone else is in the same boat.

We all help each other and we take time to listen. You will see that you are not alone. You can see the benefits of belonging to this group. You are encouraged to bring your spouse, partner, or a friend. They need these friends too. It is so nice to hear people tell me that they are not joiners and they were dubious about coming to this meeting, but after one meeting they started to learn that you are not alone, the WASPS are there when you are ready to welcome them into your life. As I am writing this report the Met Office has issued an amber weather warning for extreme heat and a drought has officially been declared affecting a large part of England, fortunately we are not in that position yet but the effects of such a dry year so far is clear to see and there have been some large field fires nearby. Whatever is happening our weather and climate has changed significantly over the last few years with hotter and drier summers and periods of heavy rain causing the misery of flooding to many people. Somerset County Council and Somerset West and Taunton Council have both declared a climate emergency recently and Parish Councils across the county are also being asked to declare a climate emergency and join the Somerset Climate Action Network. Williton Parish Council are investigating what can be done locally to mitigate for the issues raised by climate change and establish what if any actions need to be taken before a declaration is made so that it is relevant to our community rather than just making a statement without any real meaning. In the meantime, I hope you are able to keep cool and please look out for your neighbours who may be seriously affected by the heat.

Recently there has been a lot of comments about irresponsible driving and particularly speeding through the village. The Parish Council has purchased a vehicle activated speed indicator device (better known as a SID) and locations around the village where it can be used have been agreed with Somerset County Council. We are now waiting for new posts to be installed, hopefully that won't take long, and we will start to see a reduction in speeding. The Parish Council has also been working with PCSO Thompson to re-establish a Community Speedwatch group in the village, sadly the people who originally volunteered have decided that it was not for them as quite a lot of work had gone into getting sites approved and organising kit, all that was left to be done was for a training session to be completed and they would have been ready to go. Fortunately, a new volunteer has kindly agreed to be a co-ordinator for Community Speedwatch in Williton and is looking for other volunteers to assist him. If you can help please contact the Parish Office and we will pass contact details on.

Over the last few months, the number of criminals trying to scam people has increased and the Parish Council puts details of new ones it hears about in the office window to warn residents what they are doing.

To try and make more people aware of the types of fraud there is and how to protect yourselves we have arranged for a talk from the Avon and Somerset Police, Fraud and Cyber Protect Team on Friday 21st October 2022 at 2:30pm in the Pavilion. Posters advertising this will be put up around the village nearer the time.

Whilst this is not strictly for the Parish Council's report the Williton War Memorial Recreation Ground Charity has installed a Defibrillator at the Pavilion, at the time of writing it still needs the final commissioning to be completed but hopefully it will be fully working by the time you read this. This Defib together with the one on the Parish Office will be available 24 hours a day 365 days of the year. If you would like to know how these machines work and how to use them the Parish Council has arranged a training session at **6:00pm on Tuesday 8th November at the Pavilion.** Again, more details closer to the time but numbers will be limited so please book your place with the Parish Office as soon as possible if you would like to attend.

The Parish Council's constitution allows for 12 Councillors, currently there are 9 Councillors, and we are looking for 3 people to join us. If you would like to know more about what a councillor does and find out if there is a way that you can help in the way the Parish Council works please come to any of our meetings which are open to the public or speak to our Parish Clerk Michelle Francis (contact details on previous page).

AUGUST

The maximum temperature was 33.5°C on the 18th. (Not midday!)

The maximum pressure of 30.3 inches. On the 7th.

The minimum pressure of 29.75 inches. On the 24th.


The total rainfall was only 9 mm. (Extremely Low)


Williton Garden Club


