

# WHEELS-Can you help us?

If you have a car and even a little time you can spare, WHEELS, the local voluntary car scheme, would love to hear from you. Since restarting after Covid, we are helping lots of local people to attend medical and other

essential appointments. In August, there were over 50 journeys.

There are local residents, mainly elderly people, in Watchet and Williton, who are unable either to drive themselves or to catch buses, which makes it very difficult for them to keep medical or dental appointments, visit their partners or friends in care homes, do their shopping, or even just get out of the house and meet other people.

WHEELS is a group of drivers who offer personal, door to door lifts in their own cars for as low a charge as possible, to avoid the practical difficulties and sometimes the isolation of those who cannot get about under their own steam. As well as being able to claim a mileage allowance, these drivers meet some lovely passengers, and know that they are providing a service which is very much appreciated. Drivers choose the journeys they wish to undertake, which may be as frequent or occasional as they wish.

Our poor hedgehogs have had a difficult year in one way and another. What with the very dry summer and lack of rain they have had to rely on us humans for help. And help them you did! So many of you ensured that there was always a supply of fresh water in your gardens for them. A lot of hedgehogs going into a rescue were very dehydrated, some got to a rescue in time but for others it was sadly too late. One of the problems is that finders either hang on to them for a couple

of days before contacting a rescue, or don't act quickly enough when they first see a hedgehog out in the day, looking poorly or wobbly. Time is of the essence for hedgehog rescue, the quicker a hedgehog gets the medication it needs the better the chance of survival.

We are coming up to winter now and hedgehogs have been making nests, either for a cosy place to sleep on a cold night, or for hibernation. In this part of the country our winters are not usually very cold until after Christmas so our hedgehogs won't think of hibernating until the temperature drops to 5 degrees for 5 consecutive nights. If you know you have hedgehogs nesting in your garden then put out some hay near their nests. Lay a large flowerpot or bucket on its side and put hay and dried leaves in it. Your hedgehogs will be grateful for extra bedding and will happily drag it back into their nests. It is amazing how much hay a hedgehog can stuff into a hedgehog box!

If you are going to light a bonfire please build it on the day you want to light it, or move a ready built one to another place, again on the day you want to light it. The pile of vegetation and sticks you are planning to burn will be a welcome home for hedgehogs and other wildlife and you may well find that one has made a nest in the middle of your bonfire. Hedgehogs do not have a fight or flight reaction and so will just curl up. This means that they will be badly injured, or even killed by fire, something I am sure you would like to avoid at all costs.

On 17th October 2022 an Avian Influenza Prevention Zone was declared by the Government across the whole of England. This was because of the increased number of cases of the disease across the country.

All bird keepers (whether they have pet birds, commercial flocks or just a few birds in a backyard) are now required by law to take a range of precautions to protect their flocks. (Jeyes fluid is a Defra approved disinfectant for Avian Influenza).

There are minimum requirements for all bird keepers to follow. If your birds are not housed, they must be kept in fenced / enclosed outdoor areas. Precautions include (amongst others): feeding birds under cover where wild birds cannot access, preventing access by captive birds to ponds and watercourses, and effectively cleansing and disinfecting any hardstanding surfaces in areas where birds are kept.

Further enhanced measures apply for premises with over 500 poultry or other captive birds.

You can find a self-assessment checklist at the above link to help you put the measures in place, as well as more information about the virus.

You can keep up to date by regularly visiting the avian influenza section on the government website, and by registering for email or text alerts -

www.gov.uk/guidance/apha-alert-subscription-service

Remember that if you have poultry/captive birds it is your responsibility to keep updated on any outbreaks and an easy way to do this is by signing up for text notifications – register with the APHA alerts service.

If you have any concerns about the health of your birds, you should promptly speak to your vet.


The risk to public health from the virus is very low, however it is important that people don't pick up sick or dead birds. You can report finding dead wild waterfowl (swans, geese or ducks) or other dead wild birds, such as birds of prey, to the DEFRA helpline on 03459 335577.

The total months rainfall was same as August only 74mm.


#### ASTRONOMICAL NEWS






