Off she went to the glazier shop and rang the bell "service" she




At our August meeting, Wednesday 30th, we will have a Group Meeting, where you can come along with any questions you may have about your research, brick walls etc. All are welcome.



**HEDGEHOGS** 

Do you have dogs? This is something to think about if you have visiting hedgehogs in your garden. It is taken from an article by Judy Oliphant, who runs Prickles in a Pickle hedgehog rescue in Devon:

"If you have hedgehogs in your garden, or think you have them passing through, please be aware that this is a thrill to many dogs especially, terriers and hounds. The instinct to

hunt, chase and kill is innate in even the soppiest of our beloved pets and if they do it once, they will look to do it again. Terriers tend to lock their jaws and rip, hounds do the same but tend to be more finite.'

Things you can do to prevent this are training, putting the outside light on at night 10 minutes before you let your dog out, take them out on a lead, if they don't want to toilet while restricted, supervise them".

A hedgehog with a puncture wound, or ripped skin, from a dog attack will be prone to infection or will attract flies which will then lay their eggs on the animal. The eggs will hatch into maggots which will eat the flesh of the poor hedgehog. Not a nice prospect!

On a much happier note, Watchet Hedgehogs will be at the Mayfly Studio in Swain Street, Watchet, (in the gap between The Sanctuary and the charity shop) promoting awareness of wild hedgehogs, from Saturday 12th August until Sunday 20th August. There will be a hedgehog trail for children to participate in starting at the Visitor Centre and ending at the Mayfly Studio, with giveaways for every child who participates, with the opportunity to win a prize as well. Come and say hello and find out how you can make your garden hedgehog friendly.

We are sharing the Mayfly Studio with Community Men in Sheds, Taunton, who make wildlife-based items like bug houses, bird boxes, hedgehog boxes and feeders. 

# **Coleridge Cottage Nether Stowey**

Tucked away in a quiet village in Somerset lies one of the most significant buildings in the history of English literature.

Coleridge Cottage in Nether Stowey was the home of Samuel Taylor Coleridge for three years. Here he wrote some of the most beautiful and well-known poetry in the English language and collaborated with William Wordsworth on a book of poetry called The Lyrical Ballads, ushering in the English Romantic period. It is documented that whilst living here, he woke from a laudanum-dream in which came to him the poem of Kubla Khan, but was interrupted by 'a person from Porlock', and frustratingly, couldn't remember the rest of the verses.

Visitors to this unassuming cottage in Lime Street included people we now think of as giants in English Literature: William Wordsworth, Robert Southey, Charles Lamb and William Hazlitt.

The poetry that Coleridge wrote here was influenced not only by the humble cottage he lived in, but by his relationships with his wife Sara, Wordsworth and Dorothy.

This was one of the happiest times of Coleridge's life. When he moved here, he was still very much in love with his wife Sara. His relationship with the Wordsworths, who lived in Somerset for a year, changed all that. It's a fascinating story, one that you couldn't make up. It has everything: romance, friendship, jealousy, poetry, tragedy, rivalries.

The modern-day visitor to National Trust Coleridge Cottage finds that the rooms have been re-constructed to make it look like the Coleridges are still living there. In each room they will discover a different story, from the pan of spilled milk in the kitchen that led to a poem called "This Lime Tree Bower, My Prison" to the bedroom where a dress borrowed by Dorothy Wordsworth led to resentments in the Coleridge marriage.

And, if you so wish, you can be part of this story by volunteering at Coleridge Cottage. Here you have the chance to bring the Coleridge's story to life again, as well as to meet new people and make new connections every day. Whether you'd like to join us as a visitor, or a volunteer, we'd love to see you for some tea and cake in our tearoom, a stroll in our tranquil mini orchard, and welcome you into the home of Samuel Taylor Coleridge- the place that English Romanticism began.

## JULY

After the very hot June this month has proved to be rather unsettled and no extreme temperatures. This is because the jet stream is keeping the heat that Europe and further afield has been experiencing at bay.

# **JUNE**

A minimum temperature of  $7^{\circ}$ C on the 16th.

The maximum temperature was 31.4°C and for most of June above 25°C

A minimum pressure of 29.9 inches on the 18th.

A maximum pressure of 30.3 inches on the 23rd.

The total months rainfall was 45.1mm very low.

So, you will remember we had it very hot on Friday 16th & Saturday 17th temperatures here of 31.5°C, Porlock 28°C, & Yeovil 30°C.


But, of course the real heat in the week 20th on was 44<sup>o</sup>C plus was all over Southern Europe, America, Switzerland (a surprise) China and many other countries. When you read this you will have heard the maximum world temperature ever, possibly 48<sup>o</sup>C plus, many towns will have lost buildings in the wild fires as a result of the extreme heat.

## NATURE NOTES

Our blackbirds have a second (or is it the 3rd) brood of youngsters. The tadpoles in the field pond have not grown legs yet. The Buddleia is attracting several butterflies. The editor tells me he has a bumper crop of Blackcurrants so a good summer for fruits

# **ASTRONOMICAL NEWS**

If the night sky is not cloudy you may see Mars - now quite bright, Jupiter on the other side of the sky. Saturn is at its peak of brightness and is near the full Moon on the nights of 2nd and 3rd August. Then we see a second full BLUE moon at the end of the month.




